On January 27, 2011, the Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") indefinitely suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (#302723-30). Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 9, 2013, the Board of Nursing considered Respondent's request to modify the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and terminate the requirement for treatment, pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record which shows Respondent has been compliant with the terms and conditions imposed, and has the support of her treatment provider for the modifications sought, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

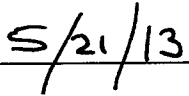
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for a modification to the frequency of drug and alcohol screens be, and hereby is, GRANTED. Respondent shall now undergo drug and alcohol screens at a frequency of not less than 28 times, including 1 hair test, per year.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request for termination of the treatment requirement be, and hereby is, GRANTED.

All other terms and conditions of the January 27, 2011 Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
