On March 24, 2011, the Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") indefinitely suspending Respondent's license to practice nursing in the state of Wisconsin. The Board subsequently granted a stay of suspension, which is contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.

Information received by the Department Monitor demonstrates that Respondent is in violation of the Order and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the stay of suspension is hereby REMOVED and Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse (#146113-30) is hereby SUSPENDED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent may petition the Board for reinstatement of the stay after demonstrating, to the satisfaction of the Board or its designee, continuous compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order for at least the most recent three (3) months.
