On April 4, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Limited License ("Order") in the above matter, which suspended Applicant's professional nursing license (#176482-30) for an indefinite period. Applicant has been granted a stay of suspension allowing her to practice with a limited license subject to certain terms and conditions.

On November 14, 2013, the Board considered Applicant's request for removal of the limitation restricting her from working in a home health care, hospice, pool nursing or agency setting. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:



ORDER

1. Applicant's request for removal of the limitation restricting her from working in a home health care, hospice, pool nursing or agency setting is hereby DENIED due to non-compliance with the Order, as evidenced by the positive drug screen without proof of a prescription and failure to adhere to the testing protocols with multiple missed tests.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
