On April 6, 2011, the Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice pharmacy in the state of Wisconsin (#7900-40) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 15, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the annual frequency of drug and alcohol screens, required pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order and the support of his Treater for the modification sought, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for a reduction in annual drug and alcohol screens be, and hereby is, GRANTED. Respondent shall now undergo drug and alcohol screens at a frequency of not less than 28 times per year, with one annual hair test.

All other terms and conditions of the April 6, 2011 not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.

This order is effective the date of its signing.
