On December 1, 2011, the Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license in the state of Wisconsin for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 10, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request for permission to work as a nurse with access to controlled substances and without direct supervision. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for permission to work as a nurse with access to controlled substances and for termination of the direct supervision requirement is hereby DENIED due to insufficient evidence of compliance with the Order, secondary to the positive drug screens in 2013.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
