On April 18, 2012, the Medical Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete four (4) hours of pre-approved continuing education in the diagnosis and treatment of post surgical complication of a total vaginal hysterectomy with an emphasis on the recognition and treatment, including referral of a foreshortened vagina, within six (6) months.


The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the continuing education requirements as ordered and, as a result, the following is entered:
