
On May 3, 2012, the Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions. Respondent's license was suspended on September 12, 2012 for failure to pay the costs of the proceeding, comply with drug and alcohol screening requirements and comply with the treatment requirements as ordered.

On September 12, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request for reinstatement of his limited license. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for termination of the suspension and reinstatement of his limited license (#119963-30) is hereby GRANTED.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
