Information submitted in support of Respondent's request for a modification to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated May 8, 2012 to decrease the frequency of drug screens was reviewed on May 24, 2013. Based upon the information of record which shows compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order, the following order is entered:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for modification of the limitations on the registered nurse license of Karen A. Costigan (#78746-30) to decrease the frequency of drug screens is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the frequency of drug screens shall be at least twenty-eight (28) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test until such time as Respondent obtains nursing employment. At such time the drug screen frequency shall increase to at least forty-eight (48) urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.

This Order is effective as of the date it is signed.
