By Order dated June 11, 2012, the Wisconsin Barbering and Cosmetology Examining Board (now, the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board) ordered Respondent to pay a forfeiture of one thousand three hundred dollars (\$1,300) and costs of the proceeding (costs) of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500). The Respondent was to make payments in installments of three hundred seventy-five (\$375) on July 31, 2012; October 31, 2012; January 31, 2013; and April 30, 2013; and three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325) on July 31, 2013; October 31, 2013; January 31, 2014; and April 30, 2014.

According to records maintained by the Department of Safety and Professional Services, the Respondent has failed to make any payments.

Pursuant to the terms of the June 11, 2012, Order, failure to make the payments as required constitutes a violation of the Order and may result in suspension of the Respondent's license without further notice or hearing.

Based upon the entire record in the above-captioned matter, the Board makes the following:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Niki T. Reed's manager license (#28641-81) is SUSPENDED until he has complied with payment of costs and forfeitures as set forth in the June 11, 2012, Order.

This Order is effective five (5) days from the date hereof.
