On June 11, 2012, the Cosmetology Examining Board ordered Respondent to pay a forfeiture in the amount of \$1,300 and costs in the amount of \$1,500 on a scheduled payment plan. On January 28, 2013, the Board suspended the license of Niki T. Reed for failing to make scheduled payments of \$375 due July 31, 2012, and \$375 due October 31, 2012.

On April 1, 2013, the Cosmetology Examining Board considered Respondent's request for reinstatement of his license and a modification to the payment plan pursuant to the Final Decision and Order of the Board dated June 11, 2012. In support of his request, Respondent submitted a payment of \$400. Based upon the information of record, the Board now finds and makes the following:

ORDER

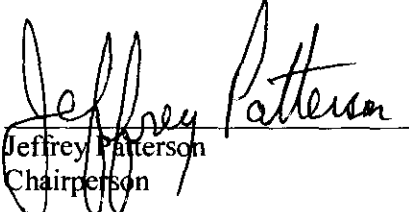
NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for reinstatement of license #28641-81 to practice as a cosmetology manager in the state of Wisconsin is hereby GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent's request for a modification to the payment plan to pay the forfeiture and costs is GRANTED as follows:

1. Respondent shall make a minimum payment of \$100 commencing May 1, 2013, and shall pay a minimum of \$100 per month thereafter until the total amount of Respondent's \$2,400 obligation is satisfied.
2. Failure to make any required payment shall be presumptive evidence of a violation of the Board's Order, which may result in further disciplinary action.
3. All provisions of the June 11, 2012, Order not otherwise modified herein shall remain in full force and effect.

This order is effective on the date signed below.
