On July 20, 2012, the Wisconsin Auctioneer Board issued a Final Decision and Order in the disciplinary proceedings referenced above, suspending Respondent's license (#486-52) for a year, requiring completion of 12 hours of auctioneer education beyond that which is necessary to maintain his registration as a condition of reinstatement, and ordering Respondent to pay \$1,000 in forfeitures.

By its authority under s. 440.22, Wis. Stats., the Auctioneer Board also ordered that Respondent pay half of the total costs of this proceeding. On or about July 23, 2012, the Board received affidavits of costs in the amounts of \$10,512.97 (08 AUC 17) and \$1,995.98 (09 AUC 6) filed by the prosecuting attorney, Sarah E. Norberg. On or about August 10, 2012, the Board received affidavits of costs in the amounts of \$1,836.10 and \$91.50 filed by Administrative Law Judges Jennifer E. Nashold and Amanda Tollefsen, respectively, of the Department of Administration, Division of Hearings and Appeals. The combined total of all amounts is \$14,436.55. The Auctioneer Board has considered the affidavits of costs, and objections thereto, if any, and issues the following Order:

ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to sec. 440.22, Wis. Stats., half of the combined total of the costs of this proceeding, or \$7,218.28 ($\$14,436.55 \div 2$), as such costs are set forth in the affidavits of Attorney Sarah E. Norberg and Administrative Law Judges Jennifer E. Nashold and Amanda Tollefsen, which affidavits are attached hereto and incorporated by reference, is assessed against Respondent. **Failure to pay the full amount assessed of \$7,218.28 within 90 days of the date of this Order shall constitute a violation of the Order, unless Respondent petitions for, and the Auctioneer Board grants, a different deadline.** Under sec. 440.22 (3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew, or otherwise issue any credential to Respondent until he or she has paid the full amount assessed.
