On August 24, 2012, the Department of Safety and Professional Services issued an order that limited Respondent's private security guard license (#36917-108) and ordered Respondent to pay costs of \$470 by November 22, 2012.

On or about January 23, 2013, Respondent petitioned the Department to extend the time period to pay the \$470 in costs, and allow him to pay \$100 per month until the total amount of costs are paid in full. Based upon the information of record, the Department now finds and makes the following:

ORDER


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the request for a modification to extend the time period to pay \$470 in costs and the request for the payment plan of \$100 per month of Scottie A. Smith (#36917-108) be and hereby is, GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the first installment shall be due thirty (30) days from the date of this order and then, every thirty (30) days thereafter until the total amount of costs is paid in full.

In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as set forth above, the Respondent's license (#36917-108) may, in the discretion of the Department or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the required payment of costs.
