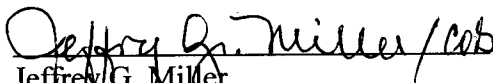

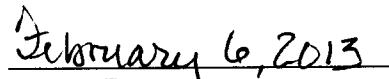
IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all limitations and encumbrances upon Maryann Thompson's license are hereby removed.
