On November 14, 2012, the Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (#34129-20) for an indefinite period. The suspension will be stayed after Respondent demonstrates 90 days of full, continuous compliance with the Order.

On March 20, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request to be excused from the drug and alcohol screening requirement while he serves on two upcoming mission trips to Haiti. Based upon the information of record, which includes evidence of non-compliance and insufficient time under the terms of the Order, the Board finds and makes the following:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Respondent's request for an interruption in drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED.
