The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent Diane M. Marschall, R.N. (dob October 18, 1963) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a professional nurse, having license number 30-113192, first issued on May 28, 1993 and current through February 28, 2014. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 9782 210<sup>th</sup> Street CT N, Forest Lake, Minnesota 55025.

2. On October 9, 2008, the State of Minnesota Board of Nursing indefinitely suspended Respondent's State of Minnesota license to practice as a professional nurse for failing to comply with a Consent Order, dated June 5, 2008.

### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation and Final Order and Decision, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Diane M. Marschall, R.N., engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined in Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.04(7).
- 3. Therefore, Respondent Diane M. Marschall, R.N., is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1)(d).

## **ORDER**

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. The SURRENDER of the license (30-113192) of Respondent Diane M. Marschall, R.N., to practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin is ACCEPTED. Respondent shall not practice nursing in the State of Wisconsin, including under the Nurse Licensure Compact, without a license from the Board.
  - 3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
