On December 14, 2012, Respondent Donald A. Wager entered into a Stipulation with the Division of Legal Services and Compliance¹ (Division) to resolve Division Case No. 12 AUC 007. On December 19, 2012, the Division added the Stipulation and related proposed Final Decision and Order to the January 23, 2013 Wisconsin Auctioneer Board (Board) meeting agenda. On January 23, 2013, the Board adopted the Stipulation and entered the Final Decision and Order.

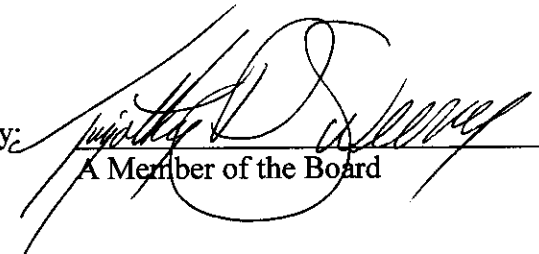
