The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Hoang-Kim Dlugi, (dob: March 13, 1961) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Manicurist, having license number 85-6966, first issued on December 10, 2007, and current through March 31, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 3030 N. 88th St., Milwaukee, WI 53222.

2. On October 4, 2012, a Department investigator conducted an unannounced inspection of North Shore Nails in Shorewood, WI.
3. The investigator observed Respondent providing an eyebrow wax.
4. Respondent is licensed as a manicurist but does not hold an aesthetician license.
5. North Shore Nails was licensed as a manicuring establishment but not an aesthetics establishment.
6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Stat. § 454.04(1)(b) and Wis. Admin. Code § BC 2.04(1) by practicing aesthetics without an aesthetician license.
3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code §§ BC 2.045(1) and BC 3.01 by practicing aesthetics outside of a licensed aesthetics establishment.
4. As a result of the above violations, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i) and 454.15(3).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. Respondent Hoang-Kim Dlugi is REPRIMANDED.
3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay a FORFEITURE in the amount of \$600.00 and COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$195.00.
4. Payment of forfeiture and costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

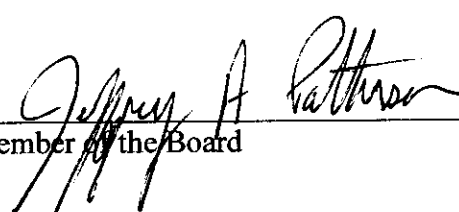

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Board in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the forfeiture and costs as ordered, Respondent's license (85-6966) may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the forfeiture and costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
