On February 4, 2013, the Psychology Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice psychology with certain terms and conditions. Respondent was ordered to complete 12 hours of education in ethics and boundaries and six hours of education in the ethical practice of forensic psychology within six months. Respondent shall also meet with a professional mentor once every two weeks to review and discuss six patent records, pursuant to the terms of the Order.

On September 9, 2013, the Board considered Respondent's request for an extension of time to complete six hours of education in the ethical practice of forensic psychology and for a reduction in the frequency of meetings with the professional mentor. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates Respondent's failure to comply with the terms of the Order, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request to extend the deadline by which he was ordered to complete six hours of education in the ethical practice of forensic psychology is hereby GRANTED.

a. Respondent shall successfully complete all education requirements of the Order, and submit proof of completion, no later than October 1, 2013.

b. Respondent is hereby notified that continued failure to comply may result in the immediate suspension of his license to practice psychology.

2. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of professional mentor meetings is hereby DENIED.

3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
