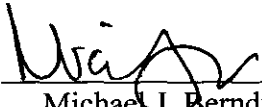
ORDER

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to § 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$2,152.70, set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Laura Varriale and Administrative Law Judge Nashold, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, are hereby assessed against the Respondents, and shall be payable by the Respondents to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of the Respondents to make payment on or before June 26, 2013, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under § 440.22(3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
