On August 15, 2011, the formal Complaint in 06 CHI 053 was filed with the Division of Hearings and Appeals. The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Chiropractic Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Scott L. Harris (dob May 6, 1958) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a chiropractor, having license number 1937-12, first issued on July 19, 1984 and current through December 12, 2014. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 123 N. Broadway Street, Stanley, Wisconsin 54768.

- 2. At the time of the events set out below, Respondent was self-employed at Harris Family Chiropractic Center in Stanley Wisconsin.
- 3. The investigation in this matter was initiated based on allegations of improper contact with female patients during examinations and treatment, improper billing practices and documentation issues.
 - 4. Respondent denies all of the above allegations.
- 5. Respondent has chosen to retire from the practice of chiropractic due to personal medical reasons.
- 6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 446.03, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Scott L. Harris, D.C., Respondent, of his license to practice chiropractic in the state of Wisconsin is ACCEPTED. Respondent shall not apply or reapply for a license from the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board and the Department of Safety and Professional Services will not process any application for renewal of the license of Scott L. Harris, D.C., from the date of this Order.
 - 3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
