The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Margaret R. Powell-Mack, R.N., (dob April 30, 1957) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a professional nurse, having license number 30-165650, first issued on November 24, 2008 and current through February 28, 2014. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 11500 22nd Avenue South, Burnsville, Minnesota 55337-1201.

- 2. On December 18, 2009, the Minnesota Board of Nursing REVOKED Respondent's State of Minnesota license to practice as a professional nurse. The violations of Minnesota Statutes are as follows:
 - a. Respondent's breach of confidentiality;
 - b. Respondent's unprofessional conduct;
 - c. Respondent's inability to practice safely by reason of psychological impairment or mental disorder; and
 - d. Respondent's substandard or inadequate care.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Margaret R. Powell-Mack, R.N., is impaired as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03(3).
- 3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Margaret R. Powell-Mack, R.N., engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined in Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.04(2).
- 4. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Margaret R. Powell-Mack, R.N., engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined in Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.04(7)
- 5. Therefore, Margaret R. Powell-Mack, R.N., is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07. (1)(c), and (d).

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. The license of Margaret R. Powell-Mack, R.N., (license no. 30-165650) to practice as a professional nurse in the State of Wisconsin, and her privilege to practice in Wisconsin pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact is REVOKED. Respondent may not petition for reinstatement of her professional nursing license pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(2) earlier than one year from the date of revocation.
- 3. Within 120 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$175.00.
- 4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:
