PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties have agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as an Amended Interim Order in this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Devinder Kaur Sidhu, M.D., (dob August 5, 1949), is licensed in the State of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 20-41617, first issued on August 27, 1999, with registration current through October 31, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 9512 43rd Avenue, Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin 53158.

2. On February 7, 2013, the Division of Legal Services and Compliance (Division) received notification from Respondent that she had been self-administering Fentanyl for her chronic pain.

3. Respondent is currently seeking medical treatment for her condition.

4. The Board has not made a determination as to the validity of the above allegation.

5. Respondent has voluntarily agreed not to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery pending the final resolution of this disciplinary matter.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3).

ORDER


1. The license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin of Respondent Devinder Kaur Sidhu, M.D., is hereby SUSPENDED, until the Medical Examining Board orders this case closed, either informally or through formal order.
