The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Laabs, Inc., is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a pharmacy, having license number 42-4891, first granted on November 25, 1967 and current through May 31, 2012. Laab's, Inc.'s most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 911 N. 27<sup>th</sup> Street, Milwaukee, WI 53208.

2. On September 27, 2011, agents of the United States Drug Enforcement Administration served a search warrant on the premises of Laabs, Inc., removing all of the

computers and much of the stock of the pharmacy, in furtherance of an investigation of large scale diversion of narcotics from the store.

3. The DEA suspended the DEA registration of Laabs, Inc. Laabs, Inc. has agreed to surrender its DEA registration, and has not renewed its pharmacy license, and has not reopened since September 27, 2011.

4. Laabs, Inc., tenders the surrender of its Wisconsin license as a pharmacy.

5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. ~~The Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 450.10(1)(b), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).~~

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent Laabs, Inc. violated Wis. Admin. Code § Phar 10.03(17) by having its DEA registration suspended.

3. As a result of the above violations, Respondent Laabs, Inc. is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 450.10(1)(b).

#### ORDER


1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
