Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Barbara Garrett Nelson, M.D., (dob October 12, 1931), is licensed in the State of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 20-49561, first issued on July 31, 2006, with registration current through October 31, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is P.O. Box 380168, Clinton Township, Michigan 48038.

2. At all times relevant to this matter, Respondent was providing locum tenens neurology department physician services for Mayo Clinic Health System in La Crosse, Wisconsin through her employer, Medical Search, LLC.

3. Respondent is under investigation as a result of providing these services.
4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).


ORDER

Nelson, M.D., will not reapply for registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future and the Department of Safety and Professional Services will not process any application for renewal of the registration of Respondent from the date of this Order.
4. The COSTS of this matter, in the amount of \$100.00, are waived, but shall be paid before any credential is issued to Respondent under Wis. Stats. chs. 440-480.
