The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Donald E. Riemer, M.D., (dob May 5, 1940), is licensed in the State of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 16138-20, first issued on September 1, 1967, with registration current through October 31, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 5670 Gable Drive #2, Eau Claire, Wisconsin 54701.

2. Respondent is currently under investigation for violation of Board Order No. 2060, dated September 19, 2012.

3. Respondent represents to the Board that he closed his office at 5:00 PM on April 25, 2013, and has not practiced medicine since that time. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

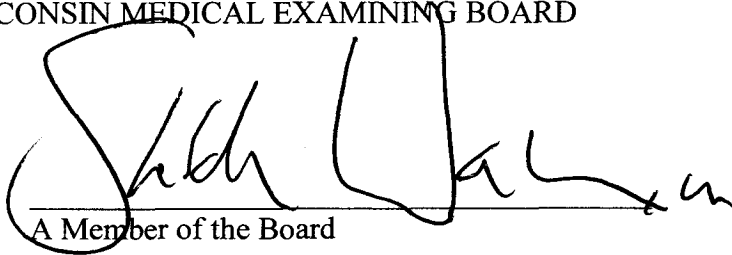
ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
2. Respondent Donald E. Riemer, M.D. (license no. 16138-20) hereby SURRENDERS his registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin, and the right to renew that registration. The Board ACCEPTS that surrender, effective the date of this Order.
3. This surrender constitutes Respondent's permanent relinquishment of his right to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin. The Board will not, at any time in the future, process or otherwise consider an application or other attempt at renewal by Respondent of credentials necessary to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin.
4. The COSTS of this matter, in the amount of \$200, are waived at this time, but shall be paid if Respondent ever applies for any credential described in Wis. Stats. chs. 440-460.
5. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
