The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Ivan Wayne Sletten, M.D., (dob September 9, 1929), is licensed in the State of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 35435-20, first issued on May 27, 1994, with registration current through October 31, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 14791 60<sup>th</sup> Street North, Stillwater, MN 55082-6382.

2. At all times relevant to this matter, Respondent was providing psychiatric services in a solo practice setting.

3. Respondent has retired from the practice of medicine and surgery due to a medical condition.

4. On January 28, 2013, Respondent voluntarily resigned his Minnesota medical license, and subsequently registered as an emeritus physician. On February 1, 2013, Respondent voluntarily surrendered his DEA registrations.

5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSION OF LAW

The Wisconsin Medical Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

#### ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Respondent Ivan W. Sletten, M.D., of his registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin (number 35435-20) and his right to renew that registration is hereby ACCEPTED.



Sletten, M.D., will not reapply for registration to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Wisconsin at any time in the future and the Department of Safety and Professional Services will not process any application for renewal of the registration of Respondent from the date of this Order.
