The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Elite Security Solutions, LLC is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a Private Detective Agency, having license number 16748-62, first issued on March 26, 2010 and current through August 31, 2013. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is 1212 North Main Street, Oshkosh, Wisconsin 54901.

2. In 2010, Respondent employed an off-duty law enforcement officer, K.S., to perform security services. Respondent did not obtain a written statement regarding who was

responsible or liable for the actions of K.S. while he was performing security services for Respondent.

3. At all times relevant to this matter, K.S. was not licensed as a private security person in Wisconsin.

4. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6) and Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01(13) by allowing an unlicensed person to perform private security duties.

3. As a result of the violations noted in the Conclusions of Law, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)2. and Wis. Admin. Code § RL (now SPS) 35.01(13).

#### ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Respondent Elite Security Solutions, LLC is REPRIMANDED.

3. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$495.00.

4. Payment of costs shall be made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services and sent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

5. Violation of any of the terms of this Order may be construed as conduct imperiling public health, safety and welfare and may result in a summary suspension of Respondent's license. The Department in its discretion may in the alternative impose additional conditions and limitations or other additional discipline for a violation of any of the terms of this Order. In the event Respondent fails to timely submit payment of the costs as ordered and as set forth above, Respondent's license (no. 16748-62) may, in the discretion of the Department, be

SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with payment of the costs.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
