PROCEDURAL HISTORY

The parties have agreed to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as an Amended Interim Order in this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Lindsay F. Mohrbacher, R.N., (dob December 27, 1983) is licensed in the State of Wisconsin as a professional nurse, having license number 154820-30, first issued on July 7, 2006 and current through February 28, 2014. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is 1901 West 6th Avenue, Brodhead, Wisconsin 53520.

- 2. On April 23, 2013, the Division of Legal Services and Compliance (Division) opened investigation 13 NUR 205 of Respondent on behalf of the Board. That investigation is based on allegations that Respondent diverted controlled substances (Dilaudid®, fentanyl and lorazepam) from a clinic (Clinic), located in Monroe, Wisconsin.
- 3. On August 20, 2013, the Division opened investigation 13 NUR 443 on behalf of the Board. That investigation is based on allegations that Respondent diverted oxycodone from a nursing home (Home), located in Monroe, Wisconsin, and falsified nursing records regarding the wasting of the oxycodone.
- 4. The Board has not made a determination as to the validity of the above allegations.
- 5. Respondent has voluntarily agreed not to engage in the practice of professional nursing pending the final resolution of these disciplinary matters.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Board of Nursing has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07.

<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. The license to practice professional nursing in the state of Wisconsin of Respondent Lindsay F. Mohrbacher, R.N., is hereby SUSPENDED, during the pendency of these disciplinary matters.
- 2. The suspension shall continue until the Board issues a Final Decision and Order in these disciplinary matters.
 - 3. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.
