On October 8, 2013, the Physical Therapy Examining Board (Board) issued its Final Decision and Order in the above-captioned matter by which the Board ordered that pursuant to §440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding be assessed against Respondent. The Board received the Affidavits of costs from the Division of Enforcement and Division of Hearings and Appeals. The Board considered the Affidavits of Costs on December 5, 2013 and orders as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that pursuant to § 440.22, Wis. Stats., the costs of this proceeding in the amount of \$23,047.42, set forth in the Affidavits of Costs of Attorney Kim Kluck and Administrative Law Judge Jennifer Nashold, are hereby assessed against Respondent, and shall be payable by Respondent to the Department of Safety and Professional Services. **Failure of Respondent to make payment on or before June 9, 2014, shall constitute a violation of the Order unless Respondent petitions for and the Board grants a different deadline.** Under § 440.22(3), Wis. Stats., the Department of Safety and Professional Services may not restore, renew or otherwise issue any credential to the Respondent until Respondent has made payment to the Department in the full amount assessed.
