The Applicant, DEBORAH MODDER, voluntarily and knowingly hereby agrees to the issuance of a LIMITED license for the purpose of completing a board-approved nurse refresher course in lieu of submitting additional information of nursing work in another jurisdiction, current education or experience which demonstrates continued competence in the field of nursing, pursuant to s. 440.08(3)(b), Stats. and s. N 5.08(2)(b), Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that a LIMITED license shall be GRANTED to the Applicant for the sole purpose of allowing participation in a board-approved nurse refresher course.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Uniform Nurse Compact, this LIMITED license for the SOLE PURPOSE of enabling the applicant to complete the refresher course is limited to Wisconsin during the pendency of this limitation. This requirement may be waived only upon the prior written authorization of both the Wisconsin Board of Nursing and the regulatory board in the state in which the applicant proposes to practice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the limited license shall be valid for one (1) year from the date of issuance. If the refresher course is not completed within one year, the limited license will expire and the Applicant will need to reapply for a limited license to complete the course.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon successful completion of the refresher course the Applicant may petition the board for reinstatement of a full license.
