On March 3, 2000, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 11, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol tests and termination of drug and alcohol treatment. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

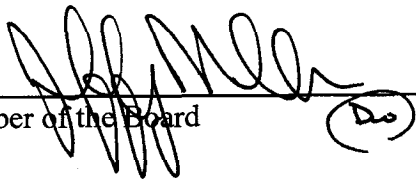
ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol tests is hereby GRANTED. The frequency is hereby reduced to not less than 36 tests per year.
2. Respondent's request for termination of drug and alcohol treatment is hereby GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
