On March 1, 2007, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On December 11, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings, reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and removal of the annual hair test. Based upon the information of record, including evidence of substantial or repeated violation of the terms of the Order by Respondent, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings, reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and removal of the annual hair test is hereby DENIED due to substantial or repeated violation of the provisions in Sections C or D of the Order.
2. The Board further removes the stay of suspension of Respondent's professional nursing license (#115710-30) pursuant to provision B.2. of the Order. This license is hereby SUSPENDED until further notice.
3. Respondent may petition the Board or its designee for reinstatement of the stay upon demonstrating continuous compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order for at least the most recent three (3) months, beginning no earlier than the date of this order.
4. This order is effective immediately.
