On May 14, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Reinstatement of Licensure with Limitations ("Order"), which reinstated Respondent's professional nursing license after revocation. Respondent's license was indefinitely suspended upon reinstatement and he has been granted a stay of suspension pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Order.

On July 10, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of AA/NA meetings, therapy sessions and drug and alcohol screens, including removal of the annual hair test. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

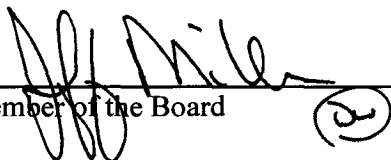
ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of AA/NA meetings is GRANTED. Respondent shall hereby attend no less than one AA/NA meeting per week.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. Respondent shall hereby test at a frequency of no less than 28 times per year. Respondent's request for removal of the annual hair test is hereby DENIED; the Board finds that the hair test remains necessary due to the reduction of drug and alcohol screens.
3. The Board did not address Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of therapy sessions. Therapy sessions shall occur at a frequency determined by Treater pursuant to provision C4 of the Order.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
