On January 22, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On February 13, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for the return of full licensure. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license (#89206-30) to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED due to a history of non-compliance with screening requirements.
