
On April 3, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued an Order Granting Reinstatement and Limited License, which reinstated Respondent's professional nursing license with an indefinite suspension following a previous revocation on February 26, 2009. Respondent was granted an immediate stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On May 8, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol tests. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol tests is GRANTED and the frequency is hereby reduced to 36 per year.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
