On May 7, 2009, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 9, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for the ability to have access to controlled substances in the workplace, the ability to work in home health care, hospice, pool nursing or agency settings and her request for a reduction in the AA/NA attendance requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the ability to have access to controlled substances and to work in home health care, hospice, pool nursing or agency settings is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in the AA/NA attendance requirement is hereby DENIED. Respondent must practice nursing under the current conditions before the Board will consider amending other requirements of the Order.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
