

On July 22, 2009, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's pharmacist license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 4, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for permission to work 24 hours per week without the direct supervision of another pharmacist. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for unsupervised practice is DENIED due to the fact that the respondent has not yet worked under supervision of a Pharmacist since the inception of the Order.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
