On May 6, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical nursing license with several terms and conditions, including: provide all supervisory personnel with a copy of the Order; arrange for nursing supervisors to submit quarterly work reports; report changes in employment status, address and phone number to the Board within five (5) days; and submit quarterly compliance reports.

On February 13, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:


ORDER
