On July 22, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

Information submitted in support of Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens has been reviewed. Based upon the information of record, which demonstrates that Respondent is eligible for a temporary reduction at this time, the following is entered:

ORDER

- 1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 24 urine screens per year and one annual hair test until he obtains employment as a nurse, at which time the frequency will be increased to 48 screens per year plus one annual hair test.
- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
 - 3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
