On August 18, 2010, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (37385-20) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On October 15, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens and the frequency of therapy visits. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

- Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED and shall occur at a frequency of not less than 14(fourteen) times per year.
- Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of therapy visits is GRANTED and shall occur at a frequency of once every (4) four months.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
