On September 2, 2010, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On January 9, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of the work-setting restrictions and a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent is hereby GRANTED termination of the work-setting restrictions, including hospice, home health, pool and agency, and termination of the direct supervision requirement.
2. Respondent needs to demonstrate continued compliance with all other terms of the Order in a less restrictive work-setting now that the work-setting restrictions have been terminated. Therefore, Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
