
On January 27, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On June 12, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for the ability to practice in a home health care setting. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request is GRANTED and she is hereby allowed to practice in home health and hospice, with access to controlled substances and without direct supervision.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
