On March 24, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including but not limited to the submission of quarterly work reports from nursing employers for a period of at least two (2) years.


On February 13, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of her license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of her professional nursing license to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED. Respondent has not been employed as a nurse and therefore the Board has not received any work reports evaluating her work performance.
