On April 20, 2011, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.
