On July 10, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for termination of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

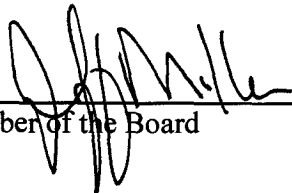
ORDER
