On September 14, 2011, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered pharmacist for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.


On February 12, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 27 urine screens per year and one (1) annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
