On October 6, 2011, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including but not limited to the submission of quarterly work reports from nursing employers for a period of at least two (2) years.



On February 13, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for removal of the limitations and the return of his license to full, unrestricted status. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the return of his professional nursing license to full, unrestricted status is hereby DENIED due to lack of compliance with the submission of quarterly work reports.
