
On July 29, 2013, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued an Order Reinstating License with Limitations ("Order") suspending Respondent's dentistry license for an indefinite period. Respondent was granted an immediate stay of suspension allowing him to practice dentistry with certain terms and conditions.

On March 5, 2014, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to 48 urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
