On January 26, 2012, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's practical nursing license for an indefinite period. The suspension may be stayed upon Respondent petitioning the Board and providing proof of compliance with Sections C and D of the Order.

Respondent's petition for an initial stay of suspension and a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol tests has been reviewed pursuant to the Order. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

#### **ORDER**

- 1. The suspension of Respondent's practical nursing license (#312179-31) is hereby STAYED. The stay is continuous, contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.
- 2. Respondent is GRANTED a temporary reduction in drug and alcohol tests. Respondent's frequency is hereby reduced to 28 urine screens per year and one annual hair test until she obtains employment as a nurse, at which time the frequency will return to 49 per year.
- 3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
  - 4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
