
On February 13, 2012, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to pay \$175 in costs of the proceeding within 180 days. Interest of 12% per annum in the amount of \$32.05 has since accrued to the amount, making the total now due \$207.05. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to pay the costs of the proceeding and accrued interest as ordered and, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's private security person credential (#34865-108) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has paid the costs of the proceeding in full, including the accrued interest.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
